Class Pricing:

Adult ~ \$25 per class or \$20 for 2 or more (same horse & same rider combo)

Gamblers Choice Class:

This class is \$25 per rider & has a pay out to top rider.

Grounds Fees:

\$10 Per horse on the grounds (Fee waived with Annual Creek Side Park Pass)

Camping:

Camping available for night prior to event, \$15 camping fee (or \$20 for Friday night - Sunday) along with \$25 facility fee which will allow you to ride the trails and practice the course until dark. Pre registration required for camping.

Directions:

From Rt 77~ @ Rt 77 & Rt 30, head East on Rt 30. Go to 2nd exit, Waynesburg/Rt 43 head south. Take this all the way down till you are almost to Downtown Waynsburg. Turn Right on Elson St (there will be a park sign and a sign for West End Pizza at Elson). Elson will dead end into the Park entrance. Levels:

Lead Line: Rider on the ground, horse on line with a person in the saddle

Novice: Walking over obstacles/lesser degree of difficulty than Level 1

Level 1: Training, Walk only, in hand or riding

Level 2: Intermediate, Walk and trot, in hand & riding. 180 & 360 degree turns on some obstacles.

Level 3: Masters, walk, trot and canter, 180 & 360 degree turns on some obstacles.

Divisions:

Novice: Limited exposure to mastering Mountain Trail obstacles. No more than 3 blue ribbons in a qualifying Trail Challenge or in the first 2 years of riding horse.

Youth: Any rider under 18 years of age.

Adult: 18 Years of age and over.

Open: All Riders Qualified except for Novice.

Trainers: Any rider who is paid to give lessons, can only go in OPEN Classes.

Junior Horse: Horses 5 years and under (This is an Open class)

Senior Horse: Horses 6 years and older (This is an Open Class)



Fun Classes:

Creative Class: Pick 16 Obstacles of your choice and show off what you and your horse can do. Can be bridleless, liberty, driving -walking (no carts).

Gamblers Choice: The rules are different. You have 2 minutes to show your skills. Navigating the obstacles is all that counts. However if a horse steps out with just one foot the obstacle does not count for a score. Each obstacle has a value which is given when show starts. You must be across the finish line when the 2 minutes are up or the score does not count.

All Breeds and all states welcome!! Forms available online and at the park

Must show at minimum 5 Challenges set up by Creek Side and hold OQHA Membership.

Creek side Annual Park Pass holders - Get a stamp card and fill up by coming to any event and earn prizes!

Within each Division, a rider can choose two Levels, In Hand or Riding, or both. We encourage doing In Hand and Riding in each. See restrictions for Divisions in rules.

Novice Riders may not ride in any Level 3, Money or Open Classes

Each Rider/Horse Combo can enter up to 2 Levels. Level 1 & 2 or Level 2 & 3
